On the request of Institute, the Canara Bank, IIT Patna, vide letter dated 4th June, 2018 has expressed its consent for installation of Locker Facility for the Institute community. For creating the facility, the Bank has to construct double lock strong room subject to a commitment from IIT Patna, not to shift the Branch Premises to other location for next 05 years. Present location of the Bank is at a centralized place, and is easily accessible to all.

The Board gave its nod to the proposal.

BOG 2018.29.12 To consider and approve the retirement age of the Medical Officers, appointed on regular basis.

Through an open selection process, the Institute has recently recruited 02 regular Medical Officers out of which one has already joined. Retirement age of medical officers has now been revised to 65 years from 60 years vide DOP&T notification dated 5th January, 2018. IIT Bombay and IIT Kanpur have already implemented the notification.

The Board approved increase in retirement age of regular Medicals Officer to 65 years in accordance with the Govt. of India notification.

Period of probation for all the appointments to permanent positions, as mentioned in Statutes 19 (1), Schedule B is as under:

"Subject to the provisions of the Act and the Statutes, all the appointments to permanent positions under the Institute shall ordinarily be made on probation for a period of one year after which period, the appointee, if confirmed, shall continue to hold office subject to the provisions of the Act and the Statutes, till the end of the month in which attains the age of superannuation, as may be prescribed from time to time".

In the consolidated instructions dated 21st July, 2014 of the DOP&T, Govt. of India on 'Probation & Confirmation', 02 years' probation period is prescribed up to level 11 and 01 year for level 12 and above.

Adoption of DOP&T, OM dated 21st July, 2014 on 'Probation and Confirmation' in totality has been approved by the Board.

At IIT Patna there are 03 sets of non-teaching employees.

- i. Employees appointed on 05 years contract.
- ii. Employees appointed on 03 years contract.
- iii. Employees appointed on probation.

With approval of the Board, cases of employees on 05 years contract were taken up for regularization after completion of their 03 years of service subject to their being otherwise eligible, as per laid down criteria. Out of 26 such employees, services of 24 employees have been regularized from the date of completion of their 03 years' service.

An apprehension has been expressed by such regularized employees, if their contractual service will be counted towards future promotions, eligibility for higher post and leave continuation/ leave encashment etc.

All these employees were appointed in regular pay-scale and were so far enjoying all the benefits, admissible to any employee appointed on regular basis. In order to avoid any disadvantage to these employees, initially appointed on contract and regularized subsequently, it was proposed to consider them on par with the regular employees for all purposes, including counting of their contractual services as experience/eligibility for any relevant purpose.

The Board directed to examine the issue in the light of Govt. of India guidelines/ practice of other IITs and to resubmit the agenda in the next meeting.

	and Confirmation of faculty members selected as Assistant Professor (on contract) and Assistant Professor (regular/Grade I).						

Offer of appointment to the post of Assistant Professor in the institute is issued in two categories:

- (a) Assistant Professor (called 'on contract' in 6 CPC and 'Grade-II' in 7 CPC)
- (b) Assistant Professor (called 'regular' in 6 CPC and 'Grade-I' in 7 CPC)

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Guidelines for Probation and Confirmation of faculty members appointed under above categories were proposed as under:

Assistant Professor (appointed on contract, Grade-II in 7 CPC):

- (i) A faculty member joining in grade-II (i.e., on contract as per 6 CPC), becomes eligible for regularization from the date he/she completes three years of post-Ph.D. experience. In this case the regularization becomes effective from the date of eligibility of the applicant, if otherwise found suitable. Following are the recommendations pertaining to probation of such employees:
 - (a) If at the time of issuing the letter of regularization, the faculty member has already served the institute for a period of one year or more since the date of eligibility, the faculty member will be regularized with effect from the date of eligibility and will be deemed confirmed in service effective from the date of completion of one year of service from the date of eligibility. No additional probation period is applicable in such case.
 - (b) If the faculty member has served the institute for a period of less than a year since the date of regularization at the time of issuing the letter of regularization, the faculty member will be considered to be on probation for the remaining period till he/she completes one year of service at the institute. Such a faculty member will be considered for confirmation effective from the date of completion of probation period, through the process in vogue for confirmation of services of faculty members in the institute.
 - (ii) If a faculty member is already eligible for regularization at the time of joining the institute, the regularization will be effective from the date of joining the institute. The process and conditions regarding probation and confirmation for such faculty members will remain the same as enunciated in (i) (a) and (i) (b) above, as the case may be.

Assistant Professor (regular/Grade I)

For a faculty member who joins the institute in grade-I, his/her case of confirmation will be considered from the date of completion of probation period by following the procedure in vogue for this purpose.

Additional Clauses

- 1. Pending procedural formalities for regularization, if a faculty member completes one year or more service from date of regularization, he/ she will also be considered to be confirmed in service as given in (i) (a).
- 2. For all purposes, the seniority of faculty members will be counted from their date of regularization.

3. Their term as Assistant Professor (Regular/Grade I) will be considered from the date of regularization on such post.

	plant at No cost to IIT under subsidy scheme of Govt.
	of India in RESCO model.

On behalf of Central Govt. Ministries, Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI) conducted a competitive bidding process to select the developers for 1000 MW capacity for government institutions for which 25 % capital subsidy was allocated. SECI has selected ReNew Solar Energy (P) Ltd (ReNew) as one of the developers for projects in Bihar. Tariff for each state was also fixed which varies from state to state. For Bihar state, the tariff is INR 4.59 per unit of solar energy fixed for a period of 25 years. It may be noted that the present rate per unit of regular electric power from the state of Bihar for IIT Patna is Rs. 7.33 per unit.

ReNew is willing to sign an agreement with IIT Patna for installation of 2 MW solar project at NO COST to IIT Patna. An area of about 5 acres of land, one each in the residential and academic zone will have to be provided for installation of Solar Power Plant. The firm has already signed an agreement with IIT Kanpur for installation and commissioning of project.

The Board observed that the per unit rate of Solar Energy is not uniform across India and differs from state to state, eg. IIT Kanpur has to pay Rs. 3.91 per unit of solar power, a rate lower than fixed for Bihar. Rate of solar power is showing a downward trend and could be cheaper in the future. Board advised the Institute to take up the issue of higher tariff with state authorities and also to refer to other economically viable schemes of the MNRE. Providing 10 acres of land for a plant of 2 MW was another concern expressed by the Board and the institute was advised to look for a roof top plant.

With the above observations, the agenda was recommended to be taken up again.

- I. A patent drive has been conducted. Decision has been taken to license a few patents immediately.
- II. Target has been set for each department and the faculty members.
- III. Head of departments and the Associate Dean (Research & Development) have been entrusted with the responsibility of identifying faculty members without project and to help them in this matter.
- IV. Alumni unit has been strengthened to keep track of our passed out students for aligning them with the Institute's interest. Post convocation alumni meet was organized in the senate hall.
- V. Efforts are on to attract the foreign students.
- VI. The Institute is now more focused on academic excellence, with the Director taking stock of quality and number of publications from each department.

- To hire professionals for PR & Marketing, including on social media. A proposal for new positions may be submitted in next meeting of the BoG.

- (i) Sophisticated Analytical Instruments Facility was created in the Institute by procuring and installing the high value sophisticated instrument with an aim to facilitate the research and to serve both internal and external users. Two such high value equipment are already functioning in the lab and procurement of 3rd Instrument namely 500 MHz NMR is under way.
 - One scientific officer was appointed initially to look after the lab. With the passage of time, the utility of SAIF has increased manifolds in terms of activities and number of users. Process for recruiting additional personnel will be initiated soon by the Institute by creating the post of **Scientific Officer** (level 10 as per 7th CPC).
- (ii) After the start of NSO program, activities related to sports have increased significantly. Appointment of **Sports Officer** (level 10 as per 7th CPC) has now become essential due to increased strength of students and introduction of variety of sports events. The person so appointed will manage and guide the coaches and PTI and will also help prepare the inter IIT team.

The strength of non-teaching employees of the Institute including the additional posts of Scientific Officer and Sports Officer will be within the

staff strength sanctioned by the BoG vide item no. 2018.27.08 and is well within the prescribed ratio of 10:1.1

The Board noted and approved the proposed recruitments.

To report about recruitment of technical staff for Institute Works Department (IWD).

Institute Works Department is responsible for creation of infrastructure inside the campus and its maintenance. Phase II construction has already been awarded to the CPWD and the Institute will soon have many more buildings. For smooth maintenance and operation, it has been decided to divide the campus into three zones, namely, Academic, Residential and Hostel Zone. Each zone will be supervised by a dedicated civil and electrical wing.

Accordingly, following additional strength has been recommended by BWC in its 29th meeting:

"Every appointment shall be subject to the condition that the appointee is certified as being in sound health and physically fit for the service, by a medical authority

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nominated by the Board: Provided that the Board may for sufficient reasons relax the medical requirement in any particular case or cases or dispense with such medical examination in any case or class of cases subject to such conditions, if any, as may be laid down by the Board."

It has been decided to introduce the requirement of medical examination of a new appointee at the time of his joining the Institute through Institute's hospital/empaneled hospitals. The present practice of having the medical examination at the time of confirmation will henceforth be discontinued.

Pending medical examination, the candidate will be allowed to join the institute provisionally.

The Board noted and approved.

BOG 2018.29.29 To report about recommendation of the committee on compensatory leave to non-teaching employees.

An in-house committee was constituted to look into the request of non-teaching employees for grant of compensatory leave, because of duties performed by them beyond office hours and/or on holidays.

While examining the issue, the committee did not find any such provision of leave in the statutes of IIT Patna. The committee urged to discourage the practice of compensatory leave strongly in an Institute of National Importance like IIT Patna.

Clause 4 (C), schedule – C of the Statutes reads as under:

"Unless otherwise stated specifically in the terms of appointment, every employee is a whole time employee of the Institute, and may be called upon to perform such duties, as may be assigned by competent authority, beyond scheduled working hours and on closed holidays and Sundays. These duties shall *inter-alia* include attendance at meetings of committees to which appointed or required by the Institute."

Board agreed with the above decision.
