The Chairman greeted the members and expressed his gratitude for attending the meeting through webex (online mode) in these trying times when entire nation is fighting against Covid-19.

The Chairman highlighted key issues as under that the Institute should consider as we plan further growth of IIT Patna.

- 1. Long-term Vision and Plan. Define a long-term vision for IIT Patna to ensure that the Institute can be considered a leading world-class institution in the next ten years (2030).
- 2. **Resources.** IIT Patna needs to become financially self-reliant as soon as possible.
- 3. Faculty hiring. Attracting and hiring the best faculty is crucial for the success of the Institute.
- 4. Environment, Society and Governance. As a progressive institution we must take a proactive stance on ESG issues.

The chairman urged the institute to set standards for the highest levels of ethics, integrity, inclusivity, and governance. As the 10-year plan is being defined, it should be ensured that we are focused on holistic growth.

A concept note covering above challenges has been already circulated by the chairman among members of the Board. He desired to have a brainstorming session on it with Board members and related functionaries /faculty members.

Board's Observation:

BOG noted with satisfaction, the approval dated 20.02.2020 received from KV Sangathan, New Delhi for opening of on campus KV up to 08th standard in the first phase.

Note: Rectifying the error through a subsequent communication, the KVS, New Delhi conveyed the revised approval till class V only. KVS is now being requested to approve opening of KV till 8th phase. standard in first However classes up to Vth standard will begin w.e.f 01st April 2020, as assured by the Deputy Commissioner, KVS. Zonal Office, Patna.

Admission process up to class v has been completed by the KV and the teachers on deputation from other KVs have been brought in.

Request of Patna for opening KV to up 8thstandard from current session was not considered favorably by the Sangathan, KV New Delhi.

Noted. Action on construction of new KV building as per master plan may be initiated at the earliest subject to availability of funds.

Comments of MoE: May be considered as per Statutes of IIT Patna and GOI rules in this regard.

With an aim to promote nurturing and advancement of human potential in a manner that is likely to improve the general abilities of the employees, a need was felt to have a liberal policy in place to permit the employees for pursuing Higher Studies outside normal office hours.

A committee of Registrar, Associate Dean (Admin.) and Associate Dean (Faculty Affairs) was constituted to review and suggest suitable modifications in the existing policy, approved by the BoG vide item No. BoG 2017.25.13 in its 25th meeting held on 05th August, 2017. After an elaborate discussion and with a view to promote knowledge enrichment though correspondence and part time courses without affecting official responsibilities, the committee has submitted its report in the form of a more liberal policy paving the way of employees to pursue higher studies in line with their roles and responsibilities at IIT Patna.

Revised policy as chalked out by the committee was approved by the Board with following amendments.

- 1. Permission to pursue a correspondence/ part time course beyond office hours will be required only in those cases where such qualification is being acquired for the purpose of promotion and an entry of the acquired qualification needs to be made in service records of an individual. An incumbent acquiring the qualification with prior permission for the purpose mentioned above, has to give an undertaking for serving the Institute for at least one year after the course completion. Date of award of degree/diploma/certificate will be the date of course completion for this purpose.
- 2. To become eligible for seeking the permission, an employee must be confirmed in his/her post.
- 3. The permission can be granted for maximum three times during the entire service career of an employee. However in exceptional cases, the Chairman BoG may grant the permission on forth occasion.

Among three officers listed above, sl. No.1 and 2 were initially appointed on contract of three years and sl. No. 3 was appointed on probation of one year.

Before 2018, at IIT Patna, appointments on non—faculty positions were being made on contract of 3/5 years, after which the employees were confirmed in their posts following due process, based on satisfactory performance. This condition of likely confirmation after the contract period is over was explicitly mentioned in respective vacancy advertisement. The principles of transparency and open and fair competition were never violated, since the applicants knew right from the advertisement stage (No. IITP/RECT./002/2016 dated 17.08.2016), like in case of probation- that confirmation will be done based on performance. In their offer letter too (Clause 01 of offer letter no. R/IITP/RECT./2017/133 dated 01.03.2017), condition of confirmation/regularization was mentioned. From 2018, the institute shifted completely to probation based appointments.

In line with the condition of confirmation mentioned in advt. and offer of appointment, people taken on board were confirmed with the approval of Chairman BoG subject to satisfactory performance evaluated by committee as per BoG approved procedure. Such confirmations were also got ratified in subsequent meetings of the BoG.

The Board ratified the confirmations. It was also directed to take legal opinion on the process adopted by the institute before remaining similarly placed cases are taken up for confirmation.

As per Rules for Allotment of Accommodation, 2015, IIT Patna, the guidelines for determining seniority and eligibility criteria for the purpose of house allotment was as follows:

- a. Grouping as per GP/AGP: All persons eligible for a particular type of house shall be grouped according to their GP/AGP. Persons with higher GP/AGP will be considered senior to those with lower GP/AGP.
- b. The effective date of joining / promotion / sanction of grade pay shall be taken into consideration in the particular group of people drawing same GP/AGP.
- c. Employee No: Seniority of persons having the same GP/AGP and having the same date of joining / promotion / sanction of grade pay shall be determined for a particular type of house in the order of Employee No. from smallest to highest.

As per Rules for allotment of accommodation (June'2017), of Ministry of Urban Development, Directorate of Estates Govt. of India, the guidelines for determining date of seniority for allotment of quarters are as under:

- The date of seniority in respect of type I to type IV accommodation shall be determined on the basis of date of joining of employees and the eligibility for type of accommodation shall be decided as per their level in the pay matrix:
- The date of seniority in respect of type IV(S) and above accommodation shall be determined on the basis of date from which an applicant has been continuously eligible for the type of accommodation as per his/her level of the in the pay matrix.

Presently the allotments up to B type quarters are being made at IIT Patna on the basis of date of joining subject to eligibility. Besides one time change in same category of quarter is also allowed. Details are as under:

A committee was proposed to be constituted for reviewing the House Allotment Rules in totality. Pending review/ finalization of House Allotment Rules, it has been decided to follow rules of Govt. of India for allotment of A type quarters (under construction).

The BoG noted. Since the institute may not have sufficient no. of employees in AGP 10500/ GP 10000 (pre-revised) when A type accommodation gets ready for allotment following Govt. rules, to prevent the revenue loss, it was directed by the BoG to consider the employees in AGP 9500(pre-revised) for allotment of surplus vacancies in A type. The priority for allotting surplus vacancies will be determined on the basis of Govt. rules i.e. date of priority shall be determined on the date from which an employee is continuously drawing the Grade Pay 9500 (Pre-revised). If date of priority is same for two or more employees, the employee having higher pay will be ranked as senior. If date of priority and pay is same; date of joining will determine the seniority. If date of priority, pay and date of joining is same; date of retirement will determine seniority.

Status of 08th Convocation of the Institute.

Owing to ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, the institute was unable to organize the Convocation ceremony which is customary for presenting degrees to pass out students. Though provisional degrees have been issued to the students, many institutions where the students apply for higher studies/ employment do not honour the provisional certificate.



In current unprecedented situation, it is unlikely to organize the convocation ceremony soon by inviting the students and guests physically. It has been therefore decided by the BoG to give away the degrees immediately. Ceremonial felicitation may be planned once the situation becomes normal.

BOG 2020.36.24 (iii)

To consider re-start of Faculty hiring process.

Permission/ suggestion of the Board was sought to initiate the shortlisting and recruitment processes of faculty hiring.

Following points were emerged during the discussion.

- 1) Ongoing shortlisting of applications for the post of Assistant Professor has to be completed by the departments at the earliest
- 2) Shortlisting of applications for the post of Associate Professor and Professor may be completed with the help of external experts. To avoid the delay, it may be done online, if possible.
- 3) Similar to many other IITs, seminar presentation and interviews may be conducted online.

Appreciating the concern, the BoG requested the Director to take appropriate steps for an early faculty hiring.

With the approval of Hon'ble Minister for Human Resource Development, first constitution of the Board of Governors IIT Patna was conveyed by the ministry vide letter dated 12th October 2009, as under.

- 1. The Chairman, to be nominated by the Visitor
- 2. Director of the mentoring institute as Vice Chairman
- 3. The Director, ex-officio
- One person to be nominated by the Government of each of the States comprising the zone in which the institute is situated – Chief Secretary/ Secretary (TE) Government of Bihar, Patna
- 5. Four persons having special knowledge or practical experience in respect of education, engineering or science, to be nominated by the council
- 6. Two professors of the institute to be nominated by the Senate The BoG was apprised of the following:
 - 1. Nominee of Govt. of Jharkhand was included in the Board at a later stage vide MHRD letter dated 28.11.2013.
 - 2. Two years term of internal members of the institute has expired on 13th June 2020.

It was directed by the BoG to get fresh nominees of the Senate as and when its next meeting is held.
