## PROCEDURAL MATTERS:

BOG	Opening remarks of the Chairman, Board of

### Comments of MoE: No comments.

The Chairman greeted the members and expressed his gratitude for attending the meeting through webex (online mode).

The Chairman praised the departments for sharing short videos and notes on their journey towards growth including advance research being carried out in different areas and the challenges they could foresee in near future. Short videos and notes shared by the Chairmen of following three committees were also appreciated with the re-iteration to do a lot more in these fields.

- 1. Health Care/Medical Services (focusing on Patna, Bihar but not limited to it.)
- 2. Smart City (energy, power, water, food all connected areas)
- 3. Problems related to Bihar; identification and possible solutions Funding agencies and Industries.

A meeting of the Chairman, Board of Governors with Heads of Departments, Chairman of respective committees and interested Board members will be arranged soon for a detailed interaction.

With above remarks, the Chairman called the meeting to order.

Minutes of 2020/37<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Board of Governors, approved by Hon'ble Chairman were circulated to all the members. Comments received from Dr.

Naveen K. Nishchal, Member BoG and the resolution of the Board are as under:

### [A] Procedural mistake:

1. In the MoM, everywhere the designation "Chairperson BoG" has been used. As per Acts and Statutes of IITP, no such designation exists. The designation what can be read in the Acts and Statutes published in The Gazette of India is "Chairman BoG". In my opinion, this needs correction.

Resolution: Correction may be made as pointed out.

2. As per the Statutes para 3.10, "The minutes of the proceedings of a meeting of the Board shall be prepared by the Registrar and circulated to all the members of the Board. The minutes, along with any amendment suggested, shall be placed for confirmation at the next meeting of the Board. After the minutes are confirmed, the minutes shall be signed by the Chairman.

The BoG meeting was held on 13th Feb 2021 and instead of circulating the draft of the MoM, duly signed MoM was circulated on 16th March 2021. This practice does not leave scope for correction and should be stopped henceforth.

Resolution: The Registrar with the approval of Director and Chairman BoG will circulate the Draft Minutes among the members for offering their comments, if any in a weeks' time. The comments so received will be submitted to the Chairman BoG for his perusal and decision. Thereafter the Minutes, duly signed by the Secretary BoG, Director IIT Patna and Chairman BOG will be circulated among the members. Confirmation of the Minutes will take place in next meeting of BoG.

# [B] Exclusion of agenda raised with due permission of Hon'ble Chairman in the MoM:

- 1. With due permission from Chair, I raised several points, out of which the following points have not been included in the MoM.
- [a] Acute shortage of faculty members in several departments who are running all the three (B. Tech., M. Tech., & Ph. D.) programs simultaneously.
- [b] Faculty recruitment in general which have not taken place for more than 21 months. This is severely hampering the growth of the Institute.
- [c] IITP was established on 6th August 2008 and now it is almost 13 years old but there is hardly any Professor in the Institute except Hon'ble Director.

Resolution: Concurrence about re-start of faculty hiring process has been recorded in the minutes of  $37^{th}$  meeting of BoG vide item no. BoG 2021.37.03 (BoG 2020.36.24 (iii). Concern expressed by the member was noted.

[d] Lots of civil construction work are going on within campus but there is no Quality Monitoring mechanism, which needs urgent attention.

Resolution: The Registrar apprised the Board about the meetings being held regularly with the CPWD to review the progress and quality of construction. NIT Patna has been engaged by the CPWD for third party inspection of

ongoing works. CPWD may be requested to make available the reports submitted by NIT Patna.

[e] There is one vehicle being used by the IWD officials for last several years. The provision for this vehicle was created when we were in transit campus 40 kms away from the permanent campus. We are on campus since August 2015, the utility of this vehicle is questionable when we have serious fund issue.

Resolution: As informed by the Registrar, in addition to IWD needs, the vehicle is being used in Institute Health Centres for bringing equipment and oxygen cylinders etc. during ongoing pandemic and for other miscellaneous purposes like bringing big consignments from the Airport and attending various assignments in Patna and other nearby places at short notice.

Vehicle to be discontinued from IWD with immediate effect. Existing IWD vehicle will be retained for multipurpose institutional work on need basis with due approval of competent authority (Dean, Administration/ Registrar/ Associate Dean, Administration) and proper logbook shall be maintained with data about user, task, approver, milage etc.

## [C] General remark:

MoM mentions presence of Mr. P. Soundrarajan, Under Secretary to the Govt. of India. His attendance may be checked from the recordings of the Meeting.

Resolution: As per statutes of IIT Patna, a member is permitted to attend the meeting in person or through video conferencing/teleconferencing. As a matter of practice, the Under Secretary/other Officers of the MoE convey the observations of the Ministry on various agenda items before the meeting which cannot be recorded as the presence of a member. Instead a reference of such communication may be inserted in the minutes.

### Comments of MoE: May be considered.

Before 2018, at IIT Patna, appointments on non –faculty positions were being made on contract of 3/5 years, after which the employees were confirmed in their posts following due process, based on satisfactory performance. This condition of likely confirmation after the contract period is over, was explicitly mentioned in respective vacancy advertisement. The principles of transparency and open and fair competition were never violated, since the applicants knew right from the advertisement stage (No. IITP/RECT./002/2016 dated 17.08.2016), like in case of probation- that confirmation will be done based on performance. In their offer letter too (Clause 01 of offer letter no. R/IITP/RECT./2017/133 dated 01.03.2017), condition of confirmation/regularization was mentioned. From 2018, the institute shifted completely to probation based appointments.

In line with the condition of confirmation mentioned in advt. and offer of appointment, people taken on board were confirmed with the approval of Chairman BoG subject to satisfactory performance evaluated by committee as per BoG approved procedure. Such confirmations were also got ratified in subsequent meetings of the BoG.

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While ratifying 02 such cases of confirmation in its meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 (details attached), the BoG directed to take legal opinion on the process adopted by the Institute before remaining similarly placed cases (list attached) are taken up for confirmation. The legal opinion of the advocate was placed before the Board in its last meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2021.

A view citing Hon'ble Supreme Court's Decision in case of Secretary, State of Karnataka vs Uma Devi is attracted in this matter, was expressed by Professor Yogesh Singh, Member BoG, prior to finalizing confirmation cases.

Opinions of 02 senior advocates viz; Mr. Naresh Dixit, Senior Standing Counsel, Hon'ble High Court Patna and Mr. V.K Upadhyaya, Senior Advocate, Hon'ble High Court, Allahabad were perused by the Board.

After detailed deliberation, the Board directed the Director to constitute a three -person committee for examining the matter in totality. The following names were suggested as possible members of this committee:

The committee may submit its report within a months' time. A special meeting of the BoG may be convened thereafter to conclude the matter.

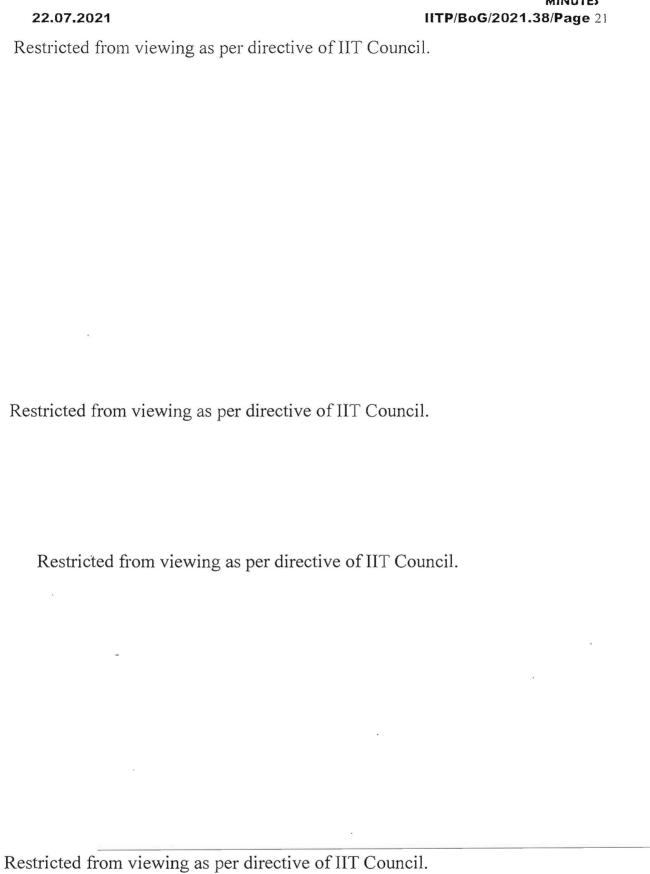

Non-teaching employees of the Institute have represented to consider their cases for next auto-upgradation after completion of minimum residency period, in line with Govt. of India guidelines. This provision of auto-upgradation; for example in case of Deputy Registrars, is not the part of our RR & PP document, though implemented in many IITs. A need was therefore felt to review the RR & PP document of IIT Patna, approved by the BoG in its 28th

meeting, for addressing the ambiguities with regards to superseding Govt. of India guidelines and other issues as may surface during the review. With the approval of BoG, usage of land measuring 500 sqm was allowed to Govt. of Bihar for establishing an on campus police outpost. The Bihar Police Bhawan Nirman Nigam vide letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 requested the institute to allocate additional 1500 sqm of land for construction of Model Police Station.

The proposal of Bihar Police Bhawan Nirman Nigam was declined by the BoG as an area of 500 sqm is enough for the construction of Police outpost. There is no such provision to provide such a large area for Police station in the Master Plan of IIT Patna.

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Prof. -in- charges have been appointed in each IIT to assist the Deans/Associate Deans for discharging day to day affairs efficiently. Since the Prof.-in-Charges devote their considerable time and energy in assisting the Deans/Associate Deans, in line with the policy of other IITs, it was proposed to grant an honorarium of Rs. 2500/- per month to each Prof.-in-Charge. The provision will put in place once the number of Prof.-in-Charges is reduced to a reasonable extent as the present number at IIT Patna is very high.

The institute health centre is presently being managed through outsourcing. The NSMCH (Netaji Subhas Medical College & Hospital) manages the Health Care Facilities of the Institute for which a handsome amount is being paid on monthly basis. With growing size of the institute, it has now become imperative to augment the infrastructure by hiring the doctors and paramedical staff etc. and purchasing necessary supportive equipment including ambulances to establish a self-dependent facility. The Institute medical committee after discussing the different requirements at length, has prepared a document on this.

The Board appreciated the efforts made by institute medical committee and desired to present a comprehensive proposal in next meeting/by circulation; Registrar and Associate Dean (Admin.) in consultation with Institute medical committee may examine the proposal carefully in light of Govt. of India guidelines.
